Various issues regarding semester end activities were discussed and the following are agreed upon:

#### 3.01 Industrial visits for providing more Practical exposure for students.

The students of 2014 batch (4<sup>th</sup> Sem.) and 2013 batch (6<sup>th</sup> Sem.) of Chemical Engineering would each be taken for Industrial visit under Chemical Engg. students Society or under Industry- Institute Interaction cell for more Practical exposure to make them confident in competitive professional environment. The batch of students would be taken according to their theoretical aspects being learnt by them till now.

#### 3.02 Upgradation of the Department library.

Since recently the department has procured more volumes for the Department library. Initiatives were taken towards its upgradation:

#### (i) Proper utilization of Chemical Engineering books:

The books would be available to students from 12PM to 2PM when the department library would be open. Mr Amarjeet would be the custodian of department library, he could be contacted for opening the library section in any exigency.

#### (ii) Addition of old semester end question papers:

Old Semester question papers would be kept in the department library for ready reference of students. A copy of the set of question papers can be made available to the department by the COE.

Each faculty member would submit sample questions of 2 marks, 5marks, and 10 marks of the subject they are teaching in the present semester for reference of students.

### (iv) E-books to be arranged for various volumes for text books & reference books:

It was decided to make available to the students E-books on a system in department library for various volumes for text books & reference books of common Chemical Engineering subjects.
