running SEEM Project in the college campus for providing education to 10+1 and 10+2 students. Under this SEEM scheme, PTU is providing free education as well as boarding and lodging facilities in the college campus to about 100 students from economical weaker sections and rural areas of Punjab.

and PWD (B&R) under the chairmanship of Head of Civil Engineering Department of GZSCET Bathinda, will visit the college to examine the cause of cracks and other deteriorations developed in the Hostel(s), the Chemical Block and/or other buildings of the college campus. The committee shall also suggest remedial measures to be taken. The committee will also

fix the responsibility for poor quality of construction of this hostel as well as other blocks/hostels and other college buildings. Further decision on who shall pay the cost of repair of these structures as well as cost of remodelling shall be taken after receiving report of the committee. It was also decided that PWD (B&R) will examine whether the hostel building is safe for occupancy or not. The committee shall submit its report within 15 days.

Action:

Inspections of the said buildings were carried out by the committee approved by the 11th BWC on 26/6/2012 & 12/7/2012. The committee observed that õa near vertical crack has appeared on the outer wall of the toilet block but this crack is not of a serious nature as it has not widened during the course of last two years or so ( as reported by the hostel wardenö). The committee suggested a four pronged strategy for this case vide its report no. 1171 dated 26/6/12. The maint. Supervisor in his report (dated 17/10/2012) submitted to the Officer In charge Maintenance, has certified that these four points have been acted upon and the cracks are filled with mortar as per verbal directions Chairman the of the of Inspection Committee(Annexure-III Page no. 37-39.

### Item No. 24.24: Payment for construction of new Lecture Halls & Tutorial Rooms.

# Item No.25.5: To ratify the payment of scale, allowances or other benefits to teaching and non-teaching employees of the college as per Notifications issued by Punjab Govt.

Punjab Govt. has issued various notifications for giving higher pay scales, allowances and other benefits to the different categories of Punjab Govt. employees. To implement these notifications for the employees of the college, an agenda item was put up in 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of Finance Committee wherein it was decided to put up this item in the combined meeting of Principals of all state managed engineering colleges.

However, due to delay in implementation of these notifications in the college, non-teaching employees had shown their resentment to the Director. Consequently, a noting no.858 dated 15-05-2012 was put up to Honøble PSTE & IT-cum-Chairman Finance Committee of this campus. Thereafter, a Memo no. 09/27/2012-TE2/1683 dated 21-05-2012 has been received from Punjab Govt. vide which it was directed that the said case may be put up in the next Finance Committee of the campus.

However, due to continue delay in implementation of these notifications in the college, various college employeesø unions met the Honøble Chairman BOG of the College and had threatened to launch an agitation if the said benefits were not given to them. Thereafter, case was put up to the Chairman BOG on a single file for approval. The Chairman BOG approved the case and sent it to Honøble Technical Education Minister, Punjab for further approval. Vide file no.381 dated 4-09-2012, Honøble Technical Education Minister, Punjab accorded his approval. Accordingly, new pay scales and allowances as notified by the Punjab Govt. were implemented to the different category of staff in the college subject to the condition of ratification in next Finance Committee.

This item was approved in the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of BOG vide Agenda Item No. 9.14.

Now above said matter is put up to Finance Committee for its kind consideration and ratification please.

#### Item No.25.6: Enhancement of students' activity related funds.

Presently, the college is charging student activity fund @ Rs.2700/- per student per semester, which needs to be revised keeping in view the huge investment to be made on the development of infrastructure of the Campus. It is proposed to charge the students activity fund @ Rs. 4250/- per student per semester from all students of B.Tech., MBA and MCA.

It is worth mentioning here that in the 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting of Finance Committee of Giani Zail Singh College of Engineering and Technology, Bathinda, it was approved to charge students activity related fund @ Rs.4250/- per semester from the students. vide agenda item No. 33.7 (Annexure-VI Page no. 106-113).

The matter was presented on a single file to Honøble PST&IT, Punjab-cum-Chairman, Finance Committee for approval (Annexure-VII Page 114). However, Punjab Govt has advised the college to put up the said matter in the next Finance Committee Meeting of the college.

Hence, the matter is placed before the Finance Committee for consideration and approval please.

### Item No.25.7: Installation of Statue of Shaheed Bhagat Singh in the Campus.

Some students of campus has requested that since the college is established on the name of õShaheed Bhagat Singhö, hence to pay a tribute to great martyr of the nation, a statue of Shaheed Bhagat Singh should be installed in the campus (Annexure-VIII page no. 115-116).

Thereafter, A Committee was constituted to review the above suggestion of students and to prepare the cost estimate for establishing the statue of great martyr Shaheed Bhagat Singh in the campus.

Committee submitted its report and given estimate of Rs. 2.5 Lacs (approx.) on installation of the statue in the campus (Annexure-VIII page no. 117). In the light of above, it is proposed to install a statue of Shaheed Bhagat Singh in the campus and Finance Committee is requested to approve the expenditure of Rs. 2.5 Lacs (approx) on the above installation.

Submitted for kind consideration and approval of the Finance Committee please.

### Item No.25.08: Monthly Payment to Non-Boarders Students and Rectification of rules of Student Exigency Fund.

As per the approval given in the 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting of Finance Committee, it was decided to give Rs.1500/- per month as the boarding/lodging charges to the students getting benefit under Student Exigency Fund. However, while deciding the cases of student exigency fund, it was found that there were some non boarder students also who were eligible for this benefit.

Therefore, it was decided in the meeting of Student Exigency Fund held on 14.05.2012 (Annexure-IX page no. 118) to give Rs.750/- per month to non boarder students for purchasing books/stationary items/travel charges from their home to the college etc.

The item is placed before the Finance Committee for kind consideration and rectification of rule as per below:

### Item No. 25.09: Payment of 80% arrear of revised pay scale to teaching faculty-regarding

Revised pay scales were given to the teaching faculty of the college as per the Punjab Govt. notification no. 2/259/09-4TE2 / 2581 dated 18-06-2010. As per the clause no. 2 (1) of the said notification, 80% arrear of the revised pay scale had to be paid by MHRD and the college shall have to pay the remaining 20% from its own sources (Annexure-X page no. 119-126).

Subsequently, as per decision of agenda item no. 24.17 of 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of Finance Committee, 20% of arrear of revised pay has already been given to teaching faulty. Now a letter no. F.1-7/2010-U.II dated New Delhi, 14<sup>th</sup> August 2012 has been issued by MHRD, Govt. of India. At serial No. 6 of this letter dated 14<sup>th</sup> August 2012 (Annexure-XI page no. 127-132), it is mentioned that:

õState Governments may please note that reimbursement of 80% of Central share of the additionally of payment of arrears, for the period 1-1-2006 to 31-3-2010, will be made by the Central Government. in 2-3 installments. However, this would be by way of reimbursement only, after the State Government has made the paymentö

Accordingly it is proposed to pay the remaining 80% of arrears of revised pay scales to teaching faulty also from the savings of Tuition Fee Accounts and the same will be put up to Punjab Govt. for getting it reimbursed from MHRD, Govt. of India.

#### Item No.25.10 To release the payment to PWD B&R for construction of 4 Lecture Hall and 4 Tutorial Rooms

A budget provision of Rs. 271.71 lacs has been made in the financial year 2012-13 for construction of 4 Lecture Hall and 4 Tutorial Rooms in the campus. As per the decision taken in the 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of finance committee, vide agenda item no. 24.24, 60% payment amounting to Rs. 148 Lac has already been released to PWD (B&R). Further it was also decided in the 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of finance committee that PWD B&R will submit the phase wise completion chart of the building to college. Accordingly the college will recommend to PSTE&IT-cum-chairman Finance Committee on single file for release of payment. Subsequently, a noting no. SBScet/Fzr/2742 dated 31.07.2012 was sent to Honøble PSTE & IT for getting permission to release the payment (Annexure-XII Page no. 133), but decision is yet to be taken.

Now PWD (B&R) have again demanded Rs. 98,45,351 vide letter no. 2043/MC dated 17-10-12 which is placed at **Annexure-IV** page no. 40. Further a letter No. A 2012/3187 dated 8.9.2012 has been received from Chief Architectural Punajb stating that the floor area in the revised architectural design has been reduced by 3483 sq. feet and hence revise cost estimate is necessitated from the Engineering Wing of PWD (Annexure-XIII page no. 134). Accordingly, a letter No. SBS/Fzr/4696 dated 18.10.2012 was written to PWD (B&R) for getting the revised cost estimate (Annexure-XIV page no. 135). However, PWD (B&R) again demanded the same amount Rs. 98,45,351 vide letter no. 2043/ML dated 17.10.2012 (Annexure-IV page no. 40). Further, the inspection report of inspection committee are also placed at Annexure-XV page no. 136.

The matter is placed before the finance committee for kind consideration and decision please.

#### Item No. 25.11: To release the payment to PWD B&R for construction of girls' hostel.

A budget provision of Rs.5.5 crore has been kept for the financial year 2012-13 for construction of boys and girls hostel. And further it was decided to approach the Punjab Technical University (PTU) Jalandhar through Punjab Govt. for getting a grant/ soft loan of Rs.10.00 crore for the construction of boys & girlsøhostels as PTU is running SEEM project in the college campus for providing education to 10+1 and 10+2 students.

Subsequently, the matter was also taken up in the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of B.O.G. in which it was decided to approach PTU, Jalandhar for grant of Rs.10.00 crore for construction of Boys Hostel. A letter No.SBSCET/FZR/4621-24 dated 15-10-2012 has already been written to Vice Chancellor of Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar in this regard (Copy is placed an **Annexure-XVI page no. 137**).

Now PWD (B&R) vide its letter no. 2042/MC dated 17-10-12 has asked the college to release Rs.430.77 lacs for the construction of Girlsø Hostel (**Annexure-XVII page no. 138-139.** Therefore, the matter is placed before the Finance Committee for allowing to release the payment of Rs. 430.77 lacs to PWD (R&B).

### Item No.25.12 To approve the budget estimates for the construction of $2^{nd}$ & $3^{rd}$ floor of a teaching Blocks-F.

As per the decision taken in the 11<sup>th</sup> meeting of Building & Works committee, an approval was given for the construction of 4 Lecture Hall & 4 Tutorial Rooms of four story building through PWD B&R which is near the completion.

Now Dean Academics with the recommendation of all HODs has submitted a requirement of 16 more Lecture Hall, which are essential for getting extension of approval (EOA) from AICTE for the existing courses (Copy of the same is placed at **Annexure-XVIII page no. 140-141**).

The PWD (B&R) has submitted a cost estimate of Rs. 327.10 Lacs for the construction of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of the Teaching Block-F. The Architectural drawings and Cost estimate submitted by PWD (B &R) is placed at **Annexure-XIX page no. 142-143.** 

Therefore approval may please be given for releasing the payment of Rs. 327.10 Lacs for the construction of 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> floor on the existing ground floor building of Block-F from the saving of Development Fund/Student Activity Fund.

#### Item No 25.13 Enhancement of transport charges from students.

Presently Rs. 210 per student is charged as transportation charges from all the students of the college. It is worth mentioning here that fuel prices have increased manifold since then. To meet out the financial loss it has become necessary to increase the rates of transport charges from students. Punjab Technical University Campus, Bathinda (PTU GZS) has increased the transportation charges from Rs. 300 to 1000 per student per semester in their 33rd meeting of Finance committee (Annexure-XX page no. 144).

So, it is proposed that from coming session Rs. 1000/- may be charged from students per semester as transport charges.

Matter is placed before the finance committee for consideration and approval please.

# Item No.25.14 Restructuring of faculty positions in different departments of B.Tech. courses and sanctioning of new posts for B.Tech. Civil course.

An agenda item No. 24.32 for restructuring the faculty positions and sanctioning the new posts for B.Tech Civil course was put up in the 24<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Finance Committee of this campus. Wherein it was decided to put up this case on a single file to the Govt. of Punjab for approval. Consequently, the case was sent to the Honøble PSTE/IT, Punjab on a single file vide noting no. SBS/FZR/861 dated: 16-05-2012. (Annexure-XXI page no. 145-146) Approval for the same is still awaited.

Since the intake of the B.Tech. courses in the campus has been substantially increased and keeping in view the larger interest of students, Finance Committee is requested to approve the restructuring of the faculty positions and sanctioning of the new posts of faculty for the B.Tech. Civil course on the basis of the recommendation of the committee constituted for this purpose as per the details placed at **Annexure-XXII page no. 147-148.** 

The brief summary of the proposed restructuring of faculty posts and sanctioning of new posts for Civil Engineering Department is given below:

It is certified that with this restructuring of faculty positions, there will be no retrenchment of the existing faculty recruited on regular basis.

#### Item No.25.15 Recruitment of Faculty at college level.

An agenda item no. 24.31 was put up in the 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of Finance Committee for recruitment of various teaching and non-teaching posts. It was decided in the meeting to put up this case on a single file to Punjab Govt. for approval. So the case was sent to Honøble PSTE/IT, Punjab for approval on a single file vide noting no. 859 dated 16-5-2012(Annexure-XXIII page no. 149-150). Approval for the same is still awaited.

Currently students are studying in 3<sup>rd</sup> semester of Civil Engineering but there is no faculty (regular/contract) in the Civil Engg. Dept. So, keeping in view the larger interest of students and a telephonic discussion with Honøble Chairman BOG a case vide noting no. 2741 dated 31-7-12 was again sent to PSTE/IT, Punjab to allow to fill at least 01 post of Associate Professor and 01 post of Assistant Professor in the Civil Engineering Department against the sanctioned vacant posts of other departments and 01 post of Associate Professor in Electrical Engineering Department against the sanctioned vacant post of Electrical Engg. Department but approval for the same is still awaited.

The above case was put up in the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of Board of Governors vide agenda item no. 9.12, it was decided by the board to recruit the faculty and other posts as per requirements. Further, it was also decided to follow college Bye-laws in recruitment and decided to ask the Govt. to review the decision of third party hiring i.e. through

NITTTR, Chandigarh as was mentioned in the Govt. letter no. 2/51/11-1ਤਿਸ/1199 dated 04-04-2011 (Annexure-XXIV page no. 151)

In the light of above facts and keeping in view the interest of students of Civil and Electrical Engineering disciplines, it is proposed to recruit teaching faculty in Electrical Engineering and Civil Engineering Department at college level as per the college bye-laws. Since the Civil Engineering Department has no sanctioned posts of faculty (Agenda for sanctioning of posts is being separately put up in this meeting), it is proposed to recruit the faculty of civil Engineering against the vacant sanctioned faculty posts of other departments as per the requirement.

It is also mentioned here that the budget provision of the above posts has been already approved in the 24<sup>th</sup> FC meeting of the campus.

Submitted for kind consideration and approval of the Finance Committee please.

### Item No.25.16 Fixing honorarium of coach engaged for different games.

To train students in various games the services of different Coach (game specialist) are required in order to train the students effectively and efficiently. Presently the institute is paying @ Rs.250/- per day to the sports persons who are engaged to train the students normally one month before the University tournament.

Since the above rates are meagre and no professional coach is willing to train the students at the said rate. Hence it is proposed to pay honorarium @ Rs.500/- per day per coach so that professional sports person can be engaged as a coach.

Submitted for kind consideration and approval of the Finance Committee please.

#### Item No. 25.17: Charging of Building funds from students-regarding

This college was established in the year 1995 with an intake of 240 students per year (total 960). The entire existing infrastructure such as Teaching blocks, Hostels & other facilities were planned as per the requirement of 240 studentsøintake. But till date many essential buildings such Central Library, Auditorium, Administrative Block, Gymnasium, Swimming Pool, Hostels, Staff Quarters, Guest House etc could not be built due to shortage of Funds. The college didnøt receive any grant from Punjab Govt. from the last 10-12 years.

Further, the intake of students has now increased to about 1300 per year (total 3800 students). Due to increased intake of students, the present infrastructure is not adequate to meet even the academic requirement. Therefore, 16 lecture halls in addition to the above mentioned buildings are urgently required to cope up with the requirement of academic, curricular & co-curricular activities of the students.

Since Punjab Govt. is not giving any grants to the College, therefore, the college is not in a position to arrange the funds required for above said purpose.

Therefore, it is proposed to charge Rs. 1,000/- per semester per student from all the students of Technical campus.
